Suspected killer of Osun nurse's wife nabbed

The Osun State Police Command has arrested one Lukman Adewale in connection with the killing of Mrs Sarah Oyediran, and two girls living with her at the Wednesday Market area of Inisa.

Sarah and two girls, whose ages were put at 14 and six, were hacked to death on Friday, July 24, 2020.

However, the deceased's husband, Mr Tunde Oyediran, a nurse, was held immediately after the incident as the police claimed they suspected foul play.

But fresh facts that emerged from investigation into the incident pointed at the 24-year-old Adewale, said to be an electronics repairer, as the alleged perpetrator of the crime.

A reliable security source, said Adewale was arrested in Osogbo following diligent investigation by police operatives.

The suspect was said to have confessed to the crime.

When contacted, the Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Yemisi Opalola, confirmed the arrest of Adewale, saying, "There is a new twist to the matter.

"A suspect that has just been arrested is helping the operatives in their investigation. Journalists will be properly briefed soon by the Commissioner of Police. His arrest was a big breakthrough in the investigation.
