Four killed in Lagos crash

Four persons have been confirmed dead in an accident on Atlantic Road in the Epe area of Lagos State.

It was gathered that a Toyota Camry, with number plate LSR 724 FW, rammed into a tricycle rider, around 4pm on Sunday.

PUNCH Metro learnt that motorist was on top speed when one of the vehicle tyres got removed, as the car rammed into the rider where he wanted to wash his tricycle.

Our correspondent learnt that the three occupants of the vehicle and the rider died on

the spot, while their corpses were deposited at the Epe General Hospital morgue.

Confirming the incident, the Head of Public Affairs Unit of the Lagos State Emergency

Management Agency, Nosa Okunbor, said, "The LRT gathered from the police officers

from the Odo-Noforija Divisional Headquarters, Epe, that the accident was as a result

of the combusted front tyre.

"While on top speed, the vehicle skidded off the road and ram into the tricycle rider,

who was trying to wash his tricycle beside the culvert, and somersaulted into the

ditch.",
