## Gunmen kill vigilante commander in Rivers

Port Harcourf— Gunmen have killed a commander of a local vigilante group in Bori, Khana Security Planning and Advisory Committee, Khana Local Government Area of Rivers State.

The victim simply identified as Saro, an indigene of Luawii community in Khana LGA, was shot on Tuesday night in front of Borimotor park by the gunmen.

A member of the group, who identified himselfas Christopher, said Saro was on his way to the motor park to board a vehicle that would take him to Port Harcourt before he was stopped and gunned down.

Christopher said: "Yesterday, one of our commanders, Saro, we were all together at our barracks in the evening later he decided to go back to Port Harcourt and as he was moving to the motor park, opposite the main park, the next thing we heard was gunshots."

Spokesman of the Rivers State, Police Command, Nnamdi Omoni, who confirmed the incident, noted that the state Commissioner of Police, Joseph Mukan, had ordered investigation into the crime to unmask the perpetrators and bring them to book.
