Meanwhile, the Bayelsa State Police Command has arrested a housewife, Eniye Zuokemefa, for alleged complicity in the killing of her husband, Enebraye Zuokemefa.

Enebraye, who lectured at the Isaac Jasper Boro College of Education, Sagbama, was reportedly murdered by gunmen on Friday.

The assailants were said to have shot him three times after he finished transacting business at a point-of-sale centre around the Ekeki area of Yenagoa.

*PUNCH Metro* gathered that his wife had allegedly threatened several times to kill her husband over allegations that he gave birth to children outside their marriage.

The state police command's spokesperson, Asinim Butswat, confirmed the arrest of the suspect, adding that she was arrested "based on suspicion of previous threats."

Meanwhile, the Ijaw Youth Council has condemned the murder.

The President of the group, Peter Igbifa, in a statement, called on security agencies and the Bayelsa State Governor, Douye Diri, to fish out the killers and bring them to book.
