Nine killed as buses collide in Delta

AT least, nine persons have reportedly died in an auto crash in Agbor, Ika South local government area of Delta

The PUNCH gathered that the ghastly auto crash occurred around 2pm on Wednesday at Alifekede community in Agbor area.

The accident was said to have involved a luxury bus that ran into a Toyota Sienna bus moving against the traffic flow (one way) lane along the Asaba/ Benin expressway.

It was gathered that not less than nine persons were confirmed dead on the spot while other passengers were rushed to the hospital by men of the Federal Road Safety Corp.

The Head of Operations, Delta State Command of Federal Road Safety Corps, Mr. Bakare Adesina, confirmed the incident and promised to get back to our correspondent on details of the accident.

Adesina, however, was unable to do that as of the time of filling this report.
