Some bandits in separate attacks, raided two local government areas of Igabi, Kajuru in Kaduna State, killing seven persons and injured

The state Commissioner for Internal Security and Home Affairs, Mr Samuel Aruwan, confirmed the attacks on Sunday in a statement.
