Man arrested for killing 57-year-old suspected of having affairs with wife

THE Adamawa State Police Command has apprehended a 30-year-old man for stabbing a 57-year-old man to death at his residence over suspicion that the victim was having an affair with his wife.

The suspect, John Samuel, a resident of Bandasarga village, Ganye Local Government Area, according to the police, returned home on Sunday around 11pm and met victim in his house.

"There and then, he suspected the victim of coming to have an affair with his wife; all of a sudden, he stabbed him with a knife and left him in a pool of blood," the state Police Public Relations Officer, Suleiman Nguroje, said.

Nguroje disclosed that the

victim identified as Yaji Lawal, a resident of Bakari Guso village, was rushed to hospital, but was later confirmed dead.

He said the police swiftly moved and arrested the culprit who is a father of three.

The state Commissioner Police. Aliyu Adamu, has ordered further investigations into the case, while also appealing for calm in the area.
