

Notorious cult leader arrested over Rivers pharmacist's death

The police said arrested a notorious cult leader, Nwimene Kapeh, who fled after allegedly beheading a pharmacist, Monaale Sunday, in Zaakpor community, in the Khana Local Government Area of Rivers State.

A senior police source confirmed the arrest to our correspondent on Sunday, saying the suspect, aka Slaughter Goat K1, committed the crime in 2019 in the presence of the deceased's wife.

Meanwhile, the widow of the slain pharmacist, Pretty Sunday, has expressed happiness over the arrest and called for justice.

Mrs. Sunday, who spoke during a news programme aired on Rhythm 93.7 Port Harcourt, and monitored by our correspondent, said the family had been in pain since her husband was killed two years ago.

"I am the wife of Mr Sunday Monaale, who was beheaded by Nwimene Kapeh on the 5th of March 2019, in my presence and his 90-year-old mother.

"I am calling on the police commissioner and the Rivers State governor to help me get justice because things have never remained the same since my husband was killed," she stated.

Efforts to reach the state Police Public Relations Officer, Nnamdi Omoni, proved abortive, as he did not take his calls or reply to a text message sent to his phone.
