Delta aggrieved wife invites siblings for help, husband stabbed to death

A 50-year-old man, identified only as Oluchi, was on Wednesday stabbed to death after a disagreement between him and his wife.

PUNCH Metro gathered that incident happened at Ulogwe-Isumpe community of Utagbe-Unor in the Ndokwa West Local Government Area of Delta State.

Trouble was said to have started when the couple had a quarrel, which degenerated into a fight.

A community source said the woman invited her siblings to come to her aid, crying on the phone that her husband wanted to kill her.

"The siblings rushed to the scene, and in the course of engaging Oluchi in a fight, one of them reached out for a kitchen knife and stabbed the man.

"He fell as neighbours arrived at the scene and rushed him to a hospital where he was confirmed dead," the source added.

Our correspondent learnt that the police arrested the wife.

The acting state Public Relations Officer, DSP Bright Edafe, confirmed the incident.

Edafe said, "It is confirmed, but I don't have details yet. The Divisional Police Officer of Kwale has already detailed his men to investigate the incident."
