

Trader, two suspected fraudsters die in Delta crashes

A truck driver has killed a trader on her way to the popular Afor Market in Ogwashi-Uku, in the Aniocha South Local Government Area of Delta State.

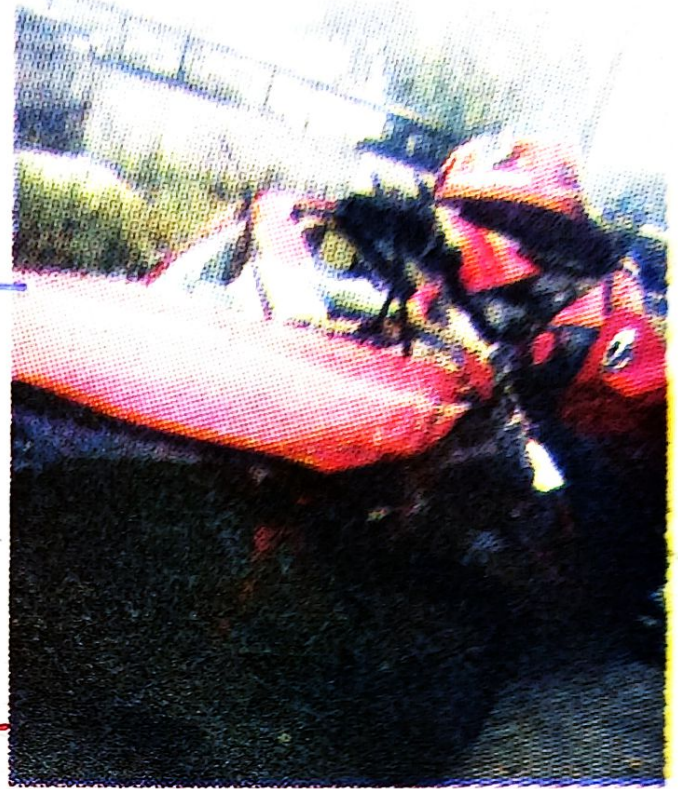
PUNCH Metro gathered that the woman was killed on Wednesday around 5pm by the hit-and-run driver, who was said to have rammed into her.

A witness said the victim was on a motorcycle when she was hit by the truck.

"The truck smashed the woman's face on the tarred road. Angry youths and residents gave the driver a chase, but they could not get him," the witness added.

2 In a related development, two suspected Internet fraudsters, aka *Yahoo boys*, have reportedly died in an auto crash, leaving one of their girlfriends in a critical condition.

The red Toyota Camry conveying the two men and the lady was said to have rammed into a median due to speeding.



• The East-West Road crash

Our correspondent gathered that the accident occurred around 11am on Wednesday on the East-West Road in Ughelli town, in the Ughelli North Local Government Area of the state.

It was learnt that the survivor lost one of her legs in the accident.

The acting Police Public Relations Officer in the state, DSP Bright Edafe, confirmed the accidents.

He said, "The truck rammed into the woman and she died on the spot, but in the Ughelli accident, the information I have is that one person died on the spot." „
