# Peacemaker stabbed scuffle in Lagos bar



PUNCH Metro gathered that one Jones Ogelejeme and a yet-to-be identified man were drinking at the bar when an argument ensued between the two men.

The argument reportedly degenerated into a fight, prompting 30-year-old Yusuf, who was also at the scene, to intervene.

Ogelejeme, 29, was said to have thought he wanted to join forces with his opponent, as he allegedly used a sharp object to



stab Yusuf in the neck. Some good Samaritans at

the bar reportedly rushed him to a hospital, where he was confirmed dead.

He said, "Jones Ogelejeme stabbed Aminu Yusuf in the neck. He (Yusuf) was rushed to the Trust in God Hospital, in the Ira area of Ojo, for quick medical treatment; he later died."

PUNCH Metro gathered that an angry mob descended on Ogelejeme and beat him to a stupor.

"He was also injured and rushed to a hospital, but he did not die. The person that died was the peacemaker," another source added.

HE Delta State Police Command has arrested four men for allegedly hijacking a truck conveying 900 bags of

He said, "On August 31, the Illah divisional patrol team was on a patrol duty along the Illah-Asaba road, when they received a report from one Bature Ibrahim, the driver of a Dangote company truck,
