

Gunmen kill Gombe hunters' commander, governor mourns

GOMBE State Governor, Muhammadu Yahaya, has commiserated with the people of Katah-Kamo village, Kamo Ward in the Kaltungo Local Government Area of the state over the demise of the commander of a local hunter group in the area,

Bello Maiduna, who was killed by unknown gunmen.

The governor's delegation on Saturday, which included Commissioner for Information and Culture, Julius Ishaya; Special Advisers on Health and Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs, Commissioner for Internal Security and Ethical Orientation,

Adamu Dishu-Kupto, said the governor was saddened by the occurrence.
