

Three die in Kwara accident, FRSC blames speed violation

Three people lost their lives in a road accident along Ilorin-Ogbomosho Expressway on Saturday.

It was gathered that the auto crash occurred in the Otte area, a boundary community between Kwara and Oyo states, around 6am as a result of speeding.

Our correspondents gathered that four persons were involved in the accident and three of them died on the spot, while the survivor sustained fracture and injury in the head.

The accident was said to have involved two vehicles; a black Toyota Corolla and a white commercial Mitsubishi van.

The state commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Jonathan Owoade, said “speed violation by the drivers of the two vehicles” was responsible for the accident.

He said, “The victims of the accident were taken to the state general hospital, Ilorin. While the survivor was admitted, the corpses of those who lost their lives were deposited at the hospital’s mortuary.”
