Two die on Ilorin-Jebba highway crash, FRSC blames burst tyre

TWO lives were lost in a lone accident on Monday in Olokonla, along Jebba-Ilorin Expressway.

According to the Federal Road Safety Corps First Information Report, the accident involved a commercial Toyota Hiace bus with number plate, BFU 947 XA, at around 4am.

The report said the accident was caused by burst tyre which made the vehicle to lose control.

Kwara state Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Mr Jonathan Owoade, who confirmed the accident, said, "Six persons were in the vehicle, including the driver. Three of the passengers were injured while the rest two died."

He said that those injured were taken to a private hospital in the area for treatment while the corpses of the dead persons were deposited in the morgue of Ilorin General Hospital.

Owoade advised drivers to pay attention to their vehicle adding that they should be properly maintained while old and faulty spare parts should be replaced.
