

The accident, which occurred around 8am, involved a Mack truck, with the number plate SMK499XU, and a Nissan car, with the number plate GH 598 LND.

A spokesperson for the Federal Road Safety Corps in Ogun State, Florence Okpe, confirmed the incident in a statement.

She said a total of five persons were involved in the crash, which she attributed to route violation and speeding.

Okpe said, "One person sustained injuries as three deaths were recorded in the crash.

"The injured victim was taken to the Victory Hospital, Ogere, for medical attention, and effort is ongoing to remove one of the trapped persons, while the other two dead bodies were deposited in the FOS morgue.
