## One dies in Anambra as rice-laden truck crashes

One person has been killed and five others injured in an accident on the Agulu Lake Bridge by Nanka Agulu Road, Anambra State.

The crash, which occurred on Monday, involved a car and a trailer.

An eyewitness, who spoke on condition of anonymity, said the trailer was carrying bags of rice and was descending the Agulu hill when it suffered a brake failure and veered off the road.

*PUNCH Metro* gathered that the injured victims were taken to the St. Joseph Hospital, where one male adult was confirmed dead by a doctor.

The corpse was reportedly deposited in the hospital's morgue.

Our correspondent observed as men of the Federal Road Safety Corps deployed in the area controlled traffic to avert a secondary crash.
