

Bandits kill nine, injure two in Kaduna – Commissioner

The Kaduna State Commissioner of Internal Security and Home Affairs, Samuel Aruwan, said bandits have killed nine persons in separate attacks in four local government areas of Chikun, Igabi, Zango-Kataf and Zaria of the

state.

The commissioner, who disclosed this on Friday, also said two persons were injured in those attacks.

Aruwan said security forces furnished the state government with the reports of the killings.

However, the Commissioner was not specific on when the incident happened.

He said the reports indicated that four persons were killed in Chikun LGA, four in Zango-Kataf LGA and one in Zaria LGA respectively.

Aruwan said, "The military and police authorities have reported to the Kaduna State Government that nine people have been killed in various attacks occurring in Chikun, Zangon Kataf, Igabi and Zaria local government areas."
