

# Delta PDP ward chairman dies after party

**A** ward chairman of the Peoples Democratic Party in Sapele, Delta State, Peter Agboghroma, aka Okponughari, is dead.

The politician reportedly died on Sunday shortly after returning from a party he was invited to by a friend.

His corpse was deposited in a mortuary.

However, one of his daughters reportedly said their late father, before his demise, instructed them not to put him in a morgue.
