Three die in Rivers road crash, FRSC blames speeding, poor visibility

HREE male adults have lost their lives in a fatal crash along the Fleme-Oxigbo Road in Rivers State.

PUNCH Metro learnt that the crash, which involved

a Toyota Hiace bus and a Mercedez Benz 911 truck, occurred around 6.35am on Wednesday.

A resident, who identified himself as ThankGod, said the bus rammed into the stationary truck, which had developed a fault and was parked two days earlier.

"There was blood all over the road. I saw policemen

attending to the victims and making phone calls probably to reach out to their families," he stated.

The Federal Road Safety Corps attributed the crash to speeding and poor visibility.

The Head of Operations, FRSC, Rivers State Command, Chukwuma Mbaegbu, said, "Yes, it happened early this morning (Wednesday). Five male adults were involved. Three died and two were injured.

"The cause of the crash was speeding and poor visibility. The injured victims were taken to the military hospital in Port Harcourt.

"The dead victims were taken to the Resurrection Hope Mortuary, Oyigbo, Rivers State."
