Gunmen kill Borno timber sellers' vice chair

Unknown gunmen have killed the Vice Chairman, Timber Sellers Association of Borno State, one Aga City, in Maiduguri, the state capital.

City was said to have been killed on Thursday night while trying to drive off after receiving the noodles he bought for his family.

City Round learnt that the father of six was shot at a close range by the gunmen who came in their numbers.

He was said to have died while being rushed to the nearest hospital.

A friend of the deceased, Simon Templer, said the assailants did not steal his car or any of his belongings after killing him.

“They neither touched any of his property nor took the car. They just shot him and left.

“The incident happened at low-cost “A”, a suburb very close to Maimalari barracks, very close to his house. The motive of shooting him has yet to be established,” Templer said.

Meanwhile, the Borno State Police Command said it had commenced an investigation.

The Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Sani Shatambaya, said, “Yes, the command is aware. But investigation is ongoing, please.”
