Two die in Lagos-Ibadan road crash, FRSC warns drivers

Twenty-four hours after an accident claimed four lives on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway, another incident has occurred, killing two persons.

The accident, which occurred on Monday around 12.20pm, left five other passengers injured.

The crash, which involved a Toyota Hiace bus with number plate, GMT 641 XL, and a Benz truck with number plate, KSF 320 XX, occurred at the Mowe Bus-Stop end of the expressway.

The Ogun State Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety Corps, Ahmed Umar, confirmed the incident.

Umar attributed the accident to speeding and dangerous driving on the part of the bus driver, which led to him ramming into the moving truck.

"A total of 20 men were involved in the accident, five of whom got injured while two deaths were recorded," he added.

The FRSC boss stated that the injured victims had been taken to Famobis Hospital, Mowe, while the deceased persons were taken away by their families.

He cautioned motorists, especially commercial drivers, against speeding and dangerous driving.
