

Nine killed in Kaduna crash, FRSC cautions motorists

The Federal Road Safety Corps has said an auto crash involving four vehicles on the Kaduna-Zaria Road claimed nine lives, while 12 others were injured.

The Kaduna Sector Commander of the Corps, Hafiz Rigim, said the accident happened around 5am on Thursday on the Rigachikun Bridge, not far from the National Open University.

Rigim said two DAF trailers, a Toyota bus and a Toyota Camry were involved in the accident.

The sector commander noted that the injured victims and the corpses were taken to the St. Gerard Hospital and Barau Dikko Teaching Hospital in Kaduna.

While admonishing motorists and other road users to always abide by traffic rules, Rigim said clearance of the obstructions caused by the accident was ongoing.

He reminded motorists and other road users going through the Kaduna-Zaria highway of ongoing road construction and diversions at Kawo, Ragachickun, Mararaban Jos, Birnin Yero and Jaji.
