Isah said, "On Saturday, August 6, 2022, around 5.30am, based on credible intelligence, the command raided terrorists' hideouts at Unguwan Dako, Tandama village, Danja LGA, and succeeded in rescuing six kidnap victims. They are Alhaji Garba DanMallam, 52; Rabiu Idris, 45; Abba Samaila, 38; Yunusa Sani, 54; Ishaq Yakub, 40, and Danjuma Samaila, 45."

Meanwhile, sources on Sunday said eight suspected terrorists, including their leader Abdulkarim Faca-Faca, were killed on Saturday when Nigerian Airforce fighter jets raided some terrorists' hideouts in the Safana LGA of the state.

The sources revealed that the raids were carried out in the evening.
