## Four killed in Kogi crash, FRSC warns drivers

POUR persons have been confirmed dead and six others injured in a motor accident on Kabba-Lokoja-Abuja Road.

The Sector Commander, Federal Road Safety

Corps, Kogi State, Stephen Dawulung, who confirmed the incident on Wednesday, said one person escaped unhurt.

Dawulung said the crash, which occurred around 3.10pm on Tuesday, involved a bus.

He said the injured persons were rescued

by personnel of the corps and rushed to a hospital in Obajana for treatment, while the four bodies were deposited in the hospital's morgue.

The FRSC boss said the accident was caused by speeding as one of the tyres deflated, resulting in a summersault.

"If the driver was not at high speed, the accident might not have occurred or it could

have been mild.

"It's unfortunate that most times you see drivers competing on the roads for no just cause, only to put their lives and those of their passengers at risk.

"We always advise that drivers should adhere to stipulated speed limits as provided for all categories of vehicles," he added.
