Husband allegedly kills wife during argument over N10m

man identified as Kelechukwu Onuka has been arrested by the men of the Ondo State Police Command for allegedly killing his wife. Onuka allegedly killed his wife over an argument on N10m at their residence in Aratunsi area of Oke Aro, Akure, Ondo State capital. The 42-year-old businessman was said to have accused his wife of hiding the money from him as they operated a joint

A source narrated that one of the deceased's family members who resides abroad sent her the N10m to assist in constructing a building for her. But the deceased, according to the source, did not inform her husband about the development.

The suspect, who learnt of the matter from another person, reportedly confronted the wife and an

argument ensued between them.

The source said, "During the argument, the husband angrily hit his wife with a heavy object on the head and she fell and died instantly.

It was gathered that the matter was reported at a police station in Akure and the suspect was arrested.

Reacting to the development, the state police spokesperson, Funmi Odunlami, on Friday confirmed the incident, adding that it was a case of domestic violence. She also confirmed the arrest of the suspect.

Odunlami said, "The suspect is already in the custody of the State Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department while investigation into the incident has commenced."

The Police Public Relations Officer in the state, Abimbola Oyeyemi, made the disclosure in a statement on Friday. Oyeyemi said the suspect was arrested following a report lodged at Mowe divisional headquarters by the mother of the victim.

The PPRO said, "The mother of the victim reported that she discovered that daughter was pregnant, and when she inquired from the daughter, she was informed that it was her father who slept with her. The victim taken to the was hospital where it was confirmed that she is

four months pregnant. Upon the report, the DPO Mowe division, SP Folake Afeniforo, quickly detailed detectives to the suspect's house where he was promptly arrested. On interrogation, the suspect confessed being responsible for his daughter's pregnancy, but claimed to be under a spell when he did it.

"He informed the police that he was dreaming having sex with his wife who had separated from him for some time now only to discover that it was her daughter that he was sleeping with."

Oyeyemi however said the Commissioner of Police, Lanre Bankole, has directed that the suspect be transferred to the anti-human trafficking and child labour unit of the state Criminal Investigation and Intelligence Department for further investigation and possible prosecution

Sexagenarian charged with drug trafficking

he National Drug Law Enforcement Agency on Friday charged a 64year- old man, Lucky Osuya, with drug trafficking. The defendant is charged before a Federal High Court in Lagos.

The News Agency of Nigeria noted that the one-count charge is marked FHC/L/590C/2022. The NDLEA alleges that the defendant committed the offence on Sept. 18, at the Ikate area of Lagos State. It said that the defendant trafficked in 230g of

According to the agency, cannabisalong with cocaine, heroin and other psychotropic substances are listed in the NDLEA Schedule as prohibited. Drug trafficking contravenes Section 11 (b) and 11(d) of the NDLEA Act of 2004, No date has been fixed for arraignment of the defendant.

Seven traffic robbers arrested in Lagos

he Lagos State Police Command said on Friday that its men from the Ketu Division arrested seven traffic robbers who attacked a motorist City Round learnt that the suspects attacked the unidentified motorist at Kosofe bus stop along Ikorodu road, and were eventually arrested during a
