Missing LAUTECH 400-level student found dead, students mourn

A 400-level student of the Ladoke Akintola University of Technology, Ogbomoso, Oyo State, Oluwatobi Ogunmola, who was declared missing a few days ago, has been found dead.

A campus source told our correspondent that his body was found hanging in a bush at Gambari, Ogbomoso, in the Surulere Local Government Area of the state.

Ogunmola, a student of the Physics Department of the school, was said to also be a mobile phone technician and solar system consultant

One of his Facebook friends, Adeleke Ayoade, while condoling with his family, wrote, "In times like this, we sympathise with the family of Ogunmola Taiwo on the death of their son, who was found dead. The death came as a shock to everyone especially the people of Gambari in Ogbomoso. Very calm and reserved brother. We pray God to console the family and rest the soul of the deceased."

The Public Relations Officer of LAUTECH, Lekan Fabiyi, said he could not say anything until the victim's studentship was confirmed.
