Four die in Lagos-Ibadan expressway crash

TOUR persons lost their lives while 11 others State capital, on Sunday. sustained varying degrees of injuries in a lone accident involving a Foton bus at the Aiyetoro around 9.59am, involved 15 people that area of the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway on Sunday. The spokesperson of the Ogun Traffic Compliance

and Enforcement Corps, Babatunde Akinbiyi, disclosed this to journalists in Abeokuta, Ogun

Akinbiyi said the accident which occurred comprised three men and 12 women

He said 11 women were injured while three

men and one woman died in the crash.

Akinbiyi said the ill-fated commercial bus somersaulted into a ditch after one of its tyres burst while in motion.

"According to an eyewitness account, the bus marked AGL 989 YA was coming from Ibadan inbound Lagos when it had a tyre burst on the driver's side at the Avetoro area on the expressway which led the bus to

somersaulting into a ditch," he said.

Akinbivi noted that the remains of the deceased were deposited at a morgue in Sagamu while the injured victims were taken to a hospital in Mowe.

He, however, called on drivers to avoid excessive speed, fairly used tyres and uphold simple traffic rules and regulations.
