Bandits kill two, abduct three in Kaduna

OME bandits were said to have raided the Dogon Noma village, Maro ward of Kajuru Local Government Area of Kaduna State, killing no fewer than two locals, and kidnapping three others on Friday.

The bandits, it was gathered, took away six motorcycles after the attack to an unknown

destination.

A source in the area told Sunday PUNCH that the bandits stormed the community in the early hours of Friday, shooting indiscriminately at the villagers, killing two during the attack.

According to the source, the villagers raised the

alarm but there was no help in good time.

He said, "When the bandits stormed the community in the early hours of Friday, we raised an alarm immediately but security men later came and pursued them out of the area.

"We later recovered two bodies while three persons were taken away by the bandits. Six motorcycles were also taken away by the bandits."

The acting Public Relations Officer of the Kaduna State Police Command, Mansir Hassan, who confirmed the attack, said the operatives were doing their best to rescue the victims unhurt.
