yet-to-be-identified female Adult has been found dead in a hotel at Morogbo in the Badagry area of Lagos State.


PUNCH Metro gathered that the incident happened on Friday, November 31, after the deceased lodged into the hotel with a male partner.

"The hotel workers searched everywhere as they were also joined by some other persons in an attempt to locate the suspect. It was difficult to locate her partner because the receptionist did not take the record of the customers. The hotel also does not have a CCTV camera," the resident added.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Benjamin Hundeyin, confirmed incident.

He said, "The corpse has been deposited in the morgue. The owner of the hotel has been arrested along the receptionist. The case will be transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department."
