The Kogi State Sector Commander of the Federal Road Safety Corps, Oyedeji Sunday, confirmed the incident to our correspondent on Friday afternoon, adding that it was caused by wrong overtaking and speeding.

Sunday added, "The accident was between a commercial motorcyclist and a Toyota Venza car. There was wrong overtaking which led to this motor accident.

"Two persons have been confirmed dead and have since been deposited in a morgue in nearby Edo State while the other person is receiving treatment at Ogori General Hospital."
