

# Police arrest 4 over murder in Ibusa

**T**HE Police in Delta State have arrested four, among them Ebuka Enenmor and Miracle Enenmor, over the killing of one Uche Osamor on March 6, 2024, at Happy Home Estate, Ibusa, Oshimili North Local Government Area of the state.

A source who confirmed the arrest to *Vanguard*, said the deceased, Osamor, was from Ogwashi town and lived with Austin Damiete, who happens to be his boss at the estate.

The source added that the suspects were arrested on March 7, 2024, alleging that the deceased's boss and suspects were into internet fraud, commonly called 419 in local parlance, and disagreement started over the sharing of money made by them.

According to the source, "The business they are into is 419. We learned that Ebuka Enenmor and Miracle Enenmor brought a 419 business to Austin Enenmor to help him collect money from bank.

"The money they got from their victim but it happened that Damiete collected the money and refused to give the money to Ebuka and Miracle.

"When they came for the money, Damiete was not at home, it was Osamor, the deceased that they met but Osamor refused to let them into the house.

"At that point, Ebuka and Miracle promised Osamor that they would come back for him and they later did with no fewer than eight men to kill him at his place. He lived with Damiete at Happy Home estate in Ibusa."

It was gathered that the police received a distress call and on their arrival at the estate, Osamor's lifeless body was recovered and evacuated to Ibusa General Hospital mortuary.

According to a police source, the suspects agreed that they went to Damiete's house but they denied killing anybody.

It was further gathered that the suspects have been moved to State Criminal Investigation Department, SCID, Asaba.
