

Police yet to identify lady found dead on Abuja road – PPRO

The Federal Capital Territory Police Command on Friday said it had launched investigations into the death of a yet-to-be-identified lady whose body was found after Mpape junction in Abuja.

The FCT Police Public Relations Officer, SP Josephine Adeh, told our correspondent that the Mabushi Division of the Force had taken the body to a hospital, adding that investigations were ongoing to identify the lady.

"Mabushi Division took the body to the hospital yesterday. We have yet to identify who she is. We are still investigating," she said.



An X user, #Arike_Jane, posted photos of the unidentified lady on Thursday, noting that no form of identification was found on the corpse to get through to her family and relatives.

"This young girl was found dead this morning, after Mpape junction, around the Abuja top bridge that connects Berger and AYA.

"They couldn't find any useful information about her or any ID to get through to her family and relatives. Anyone with useful information about her or her," she wrote.

Responding to the tweets, some users had alleged the possibility that she was a 'one-chance' victim, noting the removal of all forms of identification.

David Offor, an X user, expressed sadness over the death of the victim, stating, "It is really sad, everyone should be careful of how they move at night in Abuja. If you must go out at night, board a cab from a park, take a drop, or book any of the online logistics; 'one-chance' is still real. May she find peace".

Another user, KOA, tweeting as #KleshofAfrica, said the lady might have been attacked.

The X user said, "Because of the fact that there's no device or means of identification on her, she most definitely had been attacked and maybe robbed, and if there's any sign of injury on her body, this proves it right, that she was most definitely robbed and killed in the process. May her soul rest in peace and God forgive all her excesses."
