

# Borno man kills 90-year-old grandfather with hoe

**B**orno State Police Command has arrested 24-year-old Usakahyel Adamu for killing his grandfather with a hoe.

Parading Adamu at the command on Friday, the state Commissioner of Police Yusufu Lawal, who was represented by Kenneth Daso, said the suspect's father made the report at Kwaya Kusar police station.

Lawal who paraded the suspect on Thursday added,

"On July 7, 2024, one Adamu Yakubu male of Paga Gusi Village Kwaya – Kussar Local Government Area reported at Kwaya Kusar police station that, on the same date that his son one Usakahyel Adamu 24 years used a hoe and hit his grandfather one Yakubu Ibrahim 90 years on his head as a result he sustained serious injury and died on the spot."

While warning urging residents to remain peace-loving, Daso added, "Investigation further revealed that the said Usakahyel had an

altercation with his grandfather on an allegation that his grandfather was insulting him and pushing him without any reasonable cause.

"The suspect has been

arrested and the hoe was recovered and registered as an exhibit. Suspect will be charged to Director of Public Prosecution for legal advice and prosecution."
