THE police in Jigawa State have offered insight into the circumstances surrounding the alleged torture and killing of a 20-year-old man by an unnamed tea vendor in Dutse, the state capital.

The command's Police Public Relations Officer. DSP Lawan Shiisu, who confirmed the detention of the suspect in a statement, on Tuesday, said he would be arraigned in court as soon as investigations were concluded.

report of torture, and murder of the man.

"On August 19, the 40-year-old suspect, who resides in Sararai Village, Dutse, tied up and tortured the victim to death for stealing bread, milk, noodles, and petrol from him.

"Upon receiving the report, a patrol team promptly proceeded to the scene and arrested the

Shekoni Teaching Hospital for immediate medical attention," he said.

The PPRO added that the victim was certified

dead by a medical doctor on duty.

He said the man's remains had since been handed over to his family for burial.

On further interrogation, the police said the suspect disclosed that the deceased provoked him by stealing from him, adding that he had reported the matter to the deceased's parents.

"The suspect admitted during interrogation at the State Criminal Investigation Department, Dutse, that the deceased upset him by stealing from him.

"So, when he got the opportunity, he said he decided to tie up the teenager and beat him up," the PPRO stated.
