An eyewitness narrated to our correspondent that the alleged thief who was unaware that power would soon be restored, especially to the pole at which cables had caught his fancy climbed a high-tension pole linked to the Gombe Independent National Electoral Commission's zonal store.

According to the Gombe State Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Buhari Abdullahi, "the death was unfortunate," noting that the victim was electrocuted on the high tension.

Abdullahi continued, "The Police on duty saw someone trying to cut high tension cable that linked the pole to the transformer at Independent National Electoral Commission's Zonal Store in Gombe.

"He had already cut one of the armoured cables and in the process of cutting the second one, he got electrocuted," the Police spokesman told *Arewa PUNCH* as he shared with our correspondent pictures showing the gory sight of the headless body and remains of the thief and vandal hanging precariously atop the pole.
