One killed, seven injured in Lagos-Ibadan Expressway

vet-to-be-identified Amotorboy lost his life while seven others sustained varying degrees of injuries in two accidents that occurred at the Saapade and the Mowe sections of the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway on Tuesday.

PUNCH Metro gathered from traffic update reports by the Commandant General of the **Ogun State Traffic Compliance** and Enforcement Agency, Seni Ogunvemi, that both accidents occurred in the early hours of the day.

According to Ogunyemi, the Saapade crash involved 21 people, including 17 adults and four children.

He stressed that the accident occurred when a Mack truck collided with a Nissan bus after losing control because of brake failure.

The TRACE boss noted that six persons sustained injuries from the of the impact collision and were rescued by Good Samaritans to a hospital nearby before the arrival of emergency responders.
