An eyewitness told our correspondent that the suspect, Onyejekwe, picked a bottle and stabbed the deceased multiple times during the fight.

"Somebody was sharing rice at Boyo Road, Ogwanja in Sapele. In the process, Christian and Onyejekwe started dragging the rice which led to the fighting.

"He picked a bottle and stabbed Christian multiple times. Before the vigilante could rush him to the hospital, he was confirmed dead," the witness narrated.

Our correspondent learnt the remains of the deceased had been taken to the mortuary pending an investigation.
