
## Kidnappers kill one, abduct four in Plateau

Kidnappers abduct traditional ruler, others in Edo

According to the statement, "The Executive Chairman of Quaan-Pan Local Government Council, Hon. Christopher Audu Manship, is condoling with the people of Shendai community in Namu over the death of one person and is calling on security agencies to ensure the safe release of the abducted victims."

The council chairman reaffirmed his administration's steadfast commitment to ensuring the safety and security of all citizens, and pledged to collaborate closely with security agencies to facilitate the prompt and safe rescue of the abducted victims.

The statement also disclosed that the chairman had embarked on a fact-finding mission to the affected areas, accompanied by security operativies led by Lt. Col. Ogunrinde Soji and his team, with the aim of gaining a deeper understanding of the incident and its aftermath.

He stated that during the visit, the council boss who was also with top local government officials and four councillors of Namu District alongside the DPO Namu Police Division assessed the security situation on the ground and evaluated the affected communities.

He also paid condolences to the family of the deceased and the families of the abducted victims, offering words of comfort and reassurance.
