FRSC warns against speeding as man killed in Osun crash

A male adult (name not given) was confirmed dead in a road accident that occurred alongside the Gbongan-Ife Expressway on Wednesday.

The lone accident involving a truck was reportedly caused by brake failure leading loss of control by the driver.

The truck involved conveyed packs of non-alcoholic drink, and spilled its content after the crash.

Beside the deceased, another traveller in the vehicle was injured and rushed to the Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospital, Ile-Ife, Osun State by the men of Federal Road Safety Corps,

who responded to the distress call from the scene of accident.

In a statement by the Osun Sector Commander, FRSC, Adeyemi Sokunbi, containing details of the accident, he warned against speeding and urged the motoring public "to always make sure their vehicles are in good condition before embarking on any journey. Drivers should also shun excessive speeding."

Giving further details about the accident, the statement partly read, "Vehicle involved, 1, model, truck, nature of the road traffic accident, fatal, cause of the road traffic accident, brake failure.

"Number of people involved, 2, number injured, 1 male adult, number killed, 1 male adult. The injured victim was rushed to the OAU Teaching Hospital, Ile Ife for treatment, while the dead body was deposited at the hospital's mortuary."
