The Nigerian Air Force, as part of Operation FANSAN YAMMA Sector 1, conducted precise airstrikes that neutralised numerous terrorists in Niger State, supporting ground troops targeting those responsible for recent attacks.

The operations, executed between June 24 and 26, 2025, were guided by reliable intelligence, according to a statement by NAF's Director of Public Relations and Information, Air Commodore Ehimen Ejodame, released on Friday in Abuja.

He said the NAF had, through inter-service and inter-agency cooperation, identified terrorist activities involving attacks and cattle rustling in Kakihun and Kumbashi communities.
