Gombe road crash claims three lives

The Federal Road Safety Corps in Gombe State has confirmed the death of three members of the Boys Brigade Nigeria in a car crash that occurred along the Gombe–Billiri Road on Tuesday.

The victims were said to be travelling to Tal in Billiri Local Government Area for the funeral of a fellow Boys Brigade member and his daughter, who had earlier died in an accident at the Rainbow Roundabout.

The state Public Relations Officer of the FRSC, Janet Kassa, on Wednesday, confirmed the fatalities in a brief response to enquiries, saying, "Confirmed."

She added, "Preliminary investigation suggests tyre issues."
