# Soldiers, police deployed after two killed in Adamawa clash

TWO people were reportedly killed on Monday morning when the Fulani militias in the Chobo community and the indigeniuos Bachama in Rigange village clashed.

A resident of Rigange who identified himself as Hebron Pwavi, told *PUNCH Metro* on the telephone that two people were killed in the early hours of Monday.

"The Fulani militias who

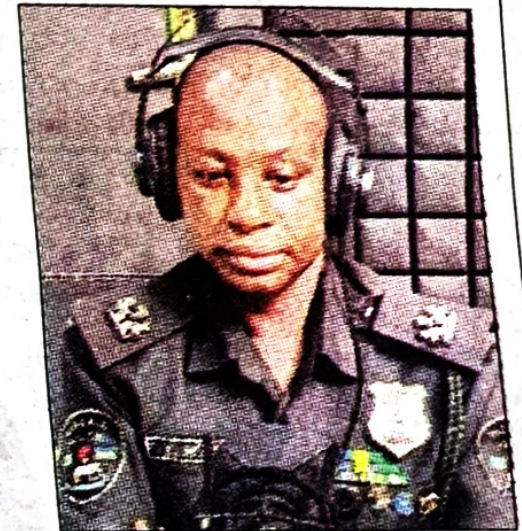
have been harassing us in our land attacked our community at about 4 am on Monday. We too quickly responded, but as of now, no security is on the ground and the attack is going on as I'm talking to you," he said.

When our correspondent contacted the Adamawa State Police Command spokesperson, SP Suleiman Nguroje, at 9:32 am, he said, "I'm not aware of that but let me contact the DPO Lamurde Local

Government Area and get back to you."

Two hours later, Nguroje released a press statement confirming the clash, saying that soldiers, police and civil defence operatives had been deployed to the troubled communities in Lamurde.

The statement said, "The Commissioner of Police, Adamawa State, Dankombo Morris, has condemned the recent unrest involving members of the Chobo and
