THE Rivers State ■ Police Command has confirmed the arrest of a 300-level undergraduate of the University of Port Harcourt identified as Cynthia Chukwundah, who burnt her 32-year-old lover. Sunny Amadi, to death in a private residence in Choba in the Obio/Akpor Local Government Area of the state.

PUNCH Metro gathered on Tuesday that the incident occurred on Sunday during a heated argument between the two lovebirds before the girl resorted to such an action.

Our correspondent learnt that the scuffle revolved around the girl's pregnancy claim, leading to her lover's death from injuries he sustained from the fire.

The spokesperson for the state police command, Grace Iringe-Koko, who confirmed the incident in a statement in Port Harcourt, the state capital, on Tuesday, also said the girl is pregnant for his late lover.

Iringe-Koko also said the girl who also suffered some burns from the inferno is receiving treatment in an undisclosed hospital under the watch of the police. saying the command had launched an investigation into the incident.

The statement read in part. The Rivers State Police Command is aware of and deeply concerned about a circulating social media report depicting a fire incident that occurred at No. 11B Okoro Street: Choba, Port Harcourt.

that the victim, who was at the hospital, was in critical condition.

"Unfortunately, the victim later succumbed to the injuries and died while on admission."

The statement continued. "The police have located Cynthia, who is currently receiving medical treatment at a hospital due to injuries she also sustained during the incident. She is also heavily pregnant with the deceased's child.

"Due to her critical condition, she is unable to provide a detailed account of the incident, but will do so when her condition is stable.

"The probable cause of the fire incident has yet to be ascertained, and a thorough investigation has been launched to unravel the circumstances surrounding the incident."
