The Kano State Police Command has arrested 11 students of Government Boarding Secondary School, Bichi, in connection with the killing of two fellow students.

Haruna said the students were being interrogated to determine their level of involvement in the incident.

"Eleven students were arrested over the incident and the investigation is ongoing to find out the level of their individual involvement," he said.
