AN Amotekun operative identified as Samuel Tope has been killed during a bloody clash with a soldier in Ijeda Ijesa community of Osun State.

PUNCH Metro also learnt that another Amotekun operative, whose name

could not be immediately ascertained, sustained serious injury in the clash.

A source in Ijeda-Ijesa, who preferred anonymity to avoid being attacked, while speaking on the incident on Sunday, said the soldier, identified as Fiyinfoluwa Opejobi, an indigene of the community,

had returned home to conclude his marriage ceremony scheduled for Saturday.

“But on Friday, he (Opejobi) was invited into the Amotekun office in Ijeda for questioning. There was a robbery incident and Opejobi was invited by the Amotekun men

for questioning over the incident. An operative of the corps raised allegations against him. He honoured the invite on Friday.

“But on Saturday, after he had concluded his mini marriage ceremony which brought him back home, he told two of his friends that joined him for the event

that someone had made a false allegation against him and they went into town to look for the person. They eventually found the man who reported him around the Ijesa Ijesa Roundabout. They beat him to a state of coma and left the scene,” a resident of the community had said.
