Bayero University, Kano, has launched a manhunt for the suspected phone snatchers who stabbed and killed a 300-level student of the institution, identified as Umar Abdullahi Hafiz.

The university's Director of Public Affairs, Lamara Garba, disclosed this in a statement on Thursday.

He said the incident occurred at the student's residence in the Dorayi area of Kano metropolis.

According to Lamara, arrangements have already been made by the university to transport the deceased's body to his hometown of Zaria, Kaduna State, for burial.
