It was during the clash that some persons torched the house and filing station belonging to Ewa Mkpang . No lives were reported lost. However, residents have deserted the place for fear of more violent attack by supporters of Ewa Mkpang who regrouped on the night of Sunday to burn the house of the Speaker's mother but were repelled by the Speaker's loyalists.
