Teenager Dies In Abortion Bid

An 18-year-old girl identified as Patricia Njoku, residing at No. 19, Oriwudeola residents of Oko-Oba, Agege recently.

A young boy called Ahmed was injured in the eye by the gang during the raid.

A distress call was, however, put through to the Divisional Police Officer (DPO) at Elere, CSP Wale Abass, who immediately deployed his men to the scene of the robbery operation. It was in the process that *Eja* was arrested.

He is currently helping the police in their investigation.

Meanwhile, residents of Festac Town in Amuwo-Odofin Local Government Council will continue to sleep with one of their eyes open as armed robbers have laid siege to the town in the last two months.

Investigation by *P.M.News* revealed that in the last two months, no fewer than six armed robbery attacks have been recorded in the area.

During the attacks, residents lost valuable items, while two persons were killed.

Unfortunately, the armed robbers were never arrested each time they struck, as they disappeared into thin air.

Last week, armed robbers in

mobile police uniform, numbering about 15, invaded the town and took over major areas. During the raid, they robbed residents freely.

The Social and Public Secretary of Canal View Residents Association, Deacon Emmanuel Ukaegbu, while confirming the incident, said the armed robbers lied that they were looking for a Redeemed Church in the area.

Redeemed Church in the area. "So, in the process of allowing them have their way, they over powered all the security men in the area before they began their operation.

He added that efforts by policemen to arrest the robbers have proved abortive, as they disappear into thin air, using shanties in the area as escape route.

P.M.News gathered that some armed robbers who operate with speed boats in Lagos, use the canal in the area as escape route and take off point to perpetrate their crime.

The robbery incident was also confirmed to *P.M.News* at Area 'E' Police Command, Festac Town.

A police source at the command said investigations have commenced in earnest and assured that the bandits would be arrested soon.

Some of the residents who spoke to *P.M.News* said they have witnessed more armed robbery attacks in the last two months than they had ever experienced in many years.
