

# Driver Kills Pedestrian

**F**or causing the death of a pedestrian, a 32-year-old man, Amidu Ahmed, has been arraigned before an Ikeja Magistrate Court for manslaughter.

He was the driver of a

Volkswagen Golf car, marked AA 591 SAG, who killed a pedestrian while driving along the Oshodi flyover last week.

The police alleged that two pedestrians were knocked down during the accident. Their names were given as Mrs. Nwosu, a Naval officer and one Kesayah Nwaije, who gave up the ghost at the Ikeja General Hospital (LASUTH), where he was rushed to after the accident.

The charge against him reads: "That you, Amidu Ahmed, on July 6, 2006 at about 11 a.m. along the Oshodi flyover drove in a reckless manner and caused the death of a pedestrian, Mrs. Kesayah Nwaije of 5, Unity Close, Ojota, Lagos.

The offence is contrary to Section 18 of the Road Traffic Act (RTA), Cap. 124, Vol. 6, Laws of Lagos State of Nigeria, 2003.

He pleaded not guilty and was granted bail in the sum of N50,000 with two sureties. The case has been adjourned for trial.
