Dare-devil armed robbers this morning raided a new generation bank on Egbe-Ikotun Road, Lagos, killing six policemen on the spot.

Dependable police sources gave the names of the policemen as ASP Mojeed, Inspector Sikiru, Sergeant Toyin, and three others including the driver simply called Orobo of the Patrol 77 team.

They were all attached to Ikotun Divisional Police Headquarters.

Investigations revealed that the policemen were on a routine patrol along Egbe-Ikotun road when they received a distress call that robbers were operating at the bank.

Sources said when the robbers sighted the policemen, they opened fire on them at a close

range. The cops, who were taken unawares, could not respond immediately.

Unconfirmed report indicated that two other policemen who were in the patrol vehicle are in critical condition and are receiving treatment in an undisclosed hospital.

The robbers, however, made away with an unspecified amount of money.

The police authorities in Lagos confirmed today's incident.

The corpses of the slain policemen have been deposited at the Ikeja General Hospital.

On 25 September this year, four policemen identified as Inspector Dashe Danladi, Sgt. Sylvester Ijegbai, Sgt. Sabiu Abdullahi and Corporal Lawrence Aba. were killed at Abule-Egba during a bank raid.

Also, on 2 October this year, four policemen, one of them identified as Corporal angelo Takaba, were gunned down at Bode Thomas, Surulere, Lagos, by armed robbers.
